Dr. Simone Dalmaso is Open Source geospatial developer at the European Commission - Joint Research Centre. He has been working as GeoNode core developer in the geo open source since 2007.

Dr. Dalmaso studied Environmental Engineering at the Politecnico di Torino and got a Ph.D. in Geomatics in the field of Humanitarian Emergency Management at ITHACA.

In 2011 he became Geospatial analyst officer at the United Nations World Food Programme, where he introduced GeoNode working on the release of GeoNode 1.2 and deployed a WFP instance.

Since 2013 he has been working at the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission as Geospatial developer, where he deployed an SDI for Syria Crisis Management.
